The **FASTDATA** Applications

FASTDATA automates the control and entry of source documents. The FASTDATA software automatically assigns document numbers, eliminating the problem of missing and duplicated numbers. Users generate forms from entered data. Obligations are posted and expenditure reporting is available. FASTDATA captures transactional information from entered documents, then reuses this data many times to fulfill supply, accounting, financial management, and contractual requirements. FASTDATA links the supply process of ordering and receiving materials and services to the accounting process.

FASTDATA consists of two interfaced applications, one for Fund Administrators and one for Sites. A Fund Administrator establishes and sends the financial framework to a Site. Site users import the financial data for local use. At scheduled times, the Sites export data back to the FA, who can export and import STARS-FL data.

If funds are available to fill the requisition, the user can create and print source documents or transfer the data for export to any automated financial or supply system. The user also can input data for receipt, cancellation, or acceptance of transactions, such as for fuel purchases, GSA orders, and SF44's. FASTDATA can maintain memorandum records pertinent to all transactions for the Site in lieu of source documents. The application also generates non-accounting forms and records data for receipt-type documents.

When the Fund Administrator imports Site data, FASTDATA groups and codes transactions in conformance with the standards used by the Fund Administrator. The Fund Administrator software retains the Sites' summary data so an accurate and current status of funds is readily available.


